



the barrel crow's nest.

Farmer's son Herbert Read was an art historian, poet, literary critic, anarchist, pacifist and philosopher. He is best known for numerous books on art (including influential writing on the role of art in education) and as co-founder of the Institute of Contemporary Arts. He was born in 1893 at Muscoates, near Nunnington, lived for many years at Stonegrave and is buried at St Gregory's Minster.




